FCCMC SCHOLARSHIP AWARD 2025

Purpose: To provide scholarships to ten (10) deserving high school graduating seniors who plan to continue their education by attending a college/university or other post-secondary educational institution. The scholarships are in the amount of \$1,000.

Criteria

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year the scholarship is awarded.
- 2. Applicant must have a minimum **GPA of 2.5** to be considered for the award.
- 3. Applicant must show evidence of community and church involvement.
- 4. Application must have a designated adult to verify packet is complete.**

Process: (Please read carefully and ensure that application is completed in its entirety.) Applicants must submit the following items: (Please check off each item before submitting)

- 1. Completed application form (please type or print legibly, using black ink).
- 2. A brief biographical sketch of applicant which also includes his/her plans for the future.
- 3. Include College Acceptance Letter.
- 4. Completed essay, using one of the three questions on separate sheet of paper. (Adhere to the guidelines within the application).
- 5. At least one letter of recommendation from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, pastor, employers, or individuals with significant knowledge of applicant.
- 6. An official school transcript or complete the School Counselor Authentication/ Evaluation part of application on last page.
- 7. Make sure that all required signatures are on application.
- 8. ALL application packets must be postmarked by **Saturday**, **April 26**, **2025** and submitted through the U.S. Postal Service. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- 9. Please mail the application to the address listed below.

Scholarships will be awarded upon the Council's receipt of documentation of enrollment at an institution. The award will be made to the student, not the institution.

NOTICE

All recipients will be notified by May 3, 2025 by phone and a Letter of Notification by email. The actual money will be awarded upon verification of enrollment in college. Students must be enrolled by the second semester.
